


Parts of a Rope

The end of a rope in use is the RUNNING END.

The other end not in use, or made fast to something, is the STAND-ING END.

The part in between the RUN-NING END and STANDING END is the STANDING PART.

In the STANDING PART can be formed a BIGHT or LOOP.
